

PRESS RELEASE

Tanzania like any other Country has adversely suffered from recent COVID-19 outbreak in the world. Tanzania Private Sector Foundation (TPSF) commends the Government of The United Republic of Tanzania for effective measures undertaken to combat the spread and impact of COVID-19 in collaboration with the private sector. TPSF and Tanzania National Business Council (TNBC) have undertaken a number of initiatives ranging from awareness creation, resources mobilization, and assessment of risks (adverse impacts) on private sector businesses in Tanzania. In addition, TPSF has administered an online Poll to collect data and information and compiled results on impact of COVID-19.

In light of the above, TPSF has formed an Advisory Committee which comprises of fourteen (14) members. **The Advisory Committee shall be guided by the following terms of reference:** -

- a. To advise on actual and potential business risks related to COVID-19 impacts on all clusters of the private sector.
- b. To advise on post-COVID-19 recuperation proposals and build a case to the Government, financiers and regional bodies on how to jointly develop recovery projects and programs.
- c. To advise on post-COVID-19 investment strategies in favor of export-oriented manufacturing in Tanzania.
- d. To provide policy recommendations to the Government on addressing the impacts of COVID-19.
